On Saturday, September 15, 2007, at 1 P.M., there will be a public dedication ceremony of a historical marker, hosted by the Polish Heritage Society of Philadelphia in cooperation with ACPC. Everyone is invited to attend. This official historical marker, commemorating Ralph Modjeski as the chief engineer and designer of the bridge, was sanctioned by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission and approved for installation

by the City of Philadelphia. It will be

located at the intersection of 6th and Race Streets, opposite the bridge, near the entrance to Franklin Park. In 2006, the Benjamin Franklin Bridge in Philadelphia celebrated its 80th Anniversary. A portrait and history of Ralph Modjeski is located in the Polish American Cultural Center Museum at 308 Walnut Street, and an outline of Modjeski is highlighted on the Museum's Internet site at: PolishAmericanCenter.com.
