Genealogy Workshop A Great Success



On Saturday, October 6, 2007, participants left the Polish American Cultural Center Museum in historic Philadelphia, very enthusiastic about the information they had received from Ceil Jensen, a certified genealogist, who had conducted a genealogy workshop at the museum.

Immigration history, Polish geography and Polish government and bureaucratic systems related to genealogical research were discussed in detail, as well as how to research Polish roots with domestic and Polish resources.

Ceil Jensen's valuable information and research skills and tools enabled the participants to conduct effective genealogical research on their own.



This program was offered with the support of the Pennsylvania Humanities Council due to growing interest in tracing family ethnic heritage. More and more individuals are expressing a desire to get back in touch with their ancestral and cultural roots.
