**Last Chance for 2006!  
 Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program**

Real Estate Taxes/Rent Rebate Program for year 2006 is closing on December 31, 2007. Get back as much as \$650 on last year's real estate taxes or rent and put it towards this year's taxes or rent. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$35,000 or less and renters with annual incomes of \$15,000, could qualify. It is important to know that only half of your Social Security or SSI counts toward the income guideline.



Four different age categories are eligible.

- 1) 65 years or older
- 2) individuals living with a spouse who is 65 years old or older
- 3) a widow or widower between the ages of 50 to 64
- 4) 100% permanently disabled individuals between the ages of 18 and 64

**LIHEAP Fuel Rebate Program  
 Now Open!**



As in previous years, the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), also known as the Fuel Rebate Program, will continue through March 21, 2008. Those who have applied in previous years should be receiving applications in the mail.

For those who are not familiar with the program, there is no age restriction to apply. The household income must be within the following guidelines:

Number in Household	Approximate Monthly Income	Annual Income
1	\$1,276	\$15,315
2	\$1,711	\$20,535
3	\$2,146	\$25,755
4	\$2,581	\$30,975
For each additional person add:	\$435	\$5,220

**Medicare Updates for November/December 2007**

The staff of Polish American Social Services reminds seniors and those on disability with Medicare benefits that the Medicare open enrollment period is from November 15th to December 31st. If you want to make a change from your present health and or prescription plan because of premiums, copays, the donut hole or drugs not covered on formularies, you have until December 31st to make those changes. Don't delay. The Pennsylvania PACE/PACENET program, now known as PACE Plus continues to enroll Pennsylvania senior citizens. PACE Plus remains a great prescription plan for seniors in Pennsylvania and works along with Medicare Part D.
