many of whom are members and supporters of the museum and its efforts to promote Polish heritage to the general public.

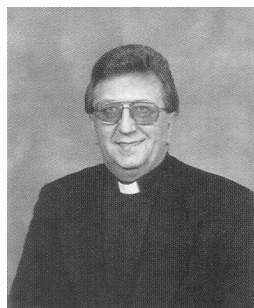
