Torun Teachers Visit Philadelphia

In October, 2008, a group of twenty-seven Philadelphians, including teachers and students from various high schools, had the great opportunity to visit Torun, Poland, Philadelphia's Sister City, when the city celebrated its 775th anniversary. During a busy week, they visited Torun, Gdansk and Warsaw, and met with Lech Walesa, the former President of the Republic of Poland and Nobel Peace Prize recipient. While in Torun, they met with students and teachers from the Tadeusz Kosciuszko High School #4. A reciprocal visit of Torun students and teachers is planned for October, 2009.

In preparation for the planned October visit, three teachers from Tadeusz Kosciuszko High School #4 were guests of Philadelphia's Swenson Arts and Technology High School and the International Visitors Council of Philadelphia in April, 2009. During their nine-day visit to Philadelphia they visited schools, historical sites, Temple University and the Polish American Cultural Center Museum. They also visited New York City, Washington, DC, and Annapolis, MD.
