

**Happy 65th Anniversary  
Msgr. Anthony Jaworowski**

On June 3, 2009, Msgr. Anthony Jaworowski, pastor emeritus of St. Adalbert Parish, Philadelphia, where he served as pastor from 1972 to 1993, and currently an active resident priest for nearly 16 years at Sacred Heart Rectory, Swedesburg, celebrated his 65th Anniversary of ordination to the priesthood.

Msgr. Jaworowski, son of the late August and Katherine (Bongard), was born on April 18, 1917 in the Manayunk section of Philadelphia. He graduated from St. Josaphat School and St. John the Baptist High School, both in Manayunk. After studying at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, he was ordained by Bishop Hugh L. Lamb on June 3, 1944. He received the title of Monsignor in 1976.

In addition to his archdiocesan assignments, he was a teacher at St. Pius X High School, Pottstown, for many years.

He has held many committee positions, such as the general chairman of arrangements of the papal visit of Pope John Paul II in 1979 and the program chairman of the 41st Eucharistic Congress held in Philadelphia in 1976.

During his distinguished priestly career, Msgr. Jaworowski was honored by many organizations for his outstanding leadership and work with the Polish American community in the United States.

In recognition of his many years of service on the board of the Polish American Cultural Center & Museum and Polish American Social Services, his fellow board members and the entire Polonia extend best wishes and dwiescie lat to Msgr. Jaworowski.

**Happy 60th Anniversary Fr. Marcel Kolakowski**

Fr. Kolakowski, a native of Philadelphia, attended St. Laurentius School and Northeast Catholic High School. Upon graduation from high school, he entered the novitiate of the Franciscan Order of the Assumption B.V.M. Province in 1941. He pronounced solemn vows on August 15, 1945. He was ordained a priest in June, 1949. Since 2002, he has served as a parochial vicar at St. John Cantius Parish in Philadelphia.

**Pennsylvania Grand Canyon Adventure

With lots of memories and fun, the Happy Travelers will finally return to Philadelphia late Sunday afternoon.
